


# Six-Patch Qube Workout Sampler

### Part 1

## Yardage and Examples of Sampler



This is an example of your sampler quilt with mystery blocks. The sash and the background are the same fabric. This quilt is designed to focus on the blocks themselves so that they are floating on the background. This sampler has the option to use the shapes in either the AccuQuilt GO! Mix & Match Qube, the Angles Companion Qube, or the Corners Companion Qube. Each week there will be three blocks—one from each of the Qubes. If you make two or all three blocks, you will have two or three quilts or a quilt that is two or three times larger than the example you see here.

Fabric selection is up to you. Because this is a sampler, you may choose to use any colors. Four colors are suggested in coordinating prints with a range of light to dark. However, you may choose a print as the primary fabric and from that print, select the colors that make up the print. Depending on the size of the Qube you are using, this is a great time to use a set of coordinating fat quarters or a set of 10" layer cake squares. Whether you use 2, 3, or 4 colors, be sure you have an equivalent yardage in the fat quarters or layer cakes.
