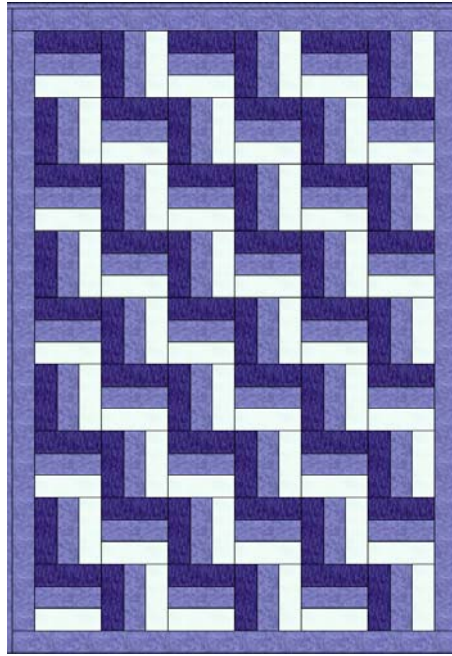


Rail Fence Quilt Instructions for Piecing



Finished size 40 x 58 inches

Cutting Instructions (for Accuquilt GO):

Cut 4 each width of fabric strips that are 6 ½ inches x 40 inches (width of the fabric) of the dark, medium, and light fabrics (12 ea 6 ½ x 40 inch strips).
Fanfold these across the 2 ½ inch strip die and cut into 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch strips.

Cutting Instructions using Rotary Cutter:

Cut 54 pieces 2 ½ x 6 ½ inches of dark strips.
Cut 54 pieces 2 ½ x 6 ½ inches of medium strips.
Cut 54 pieces 2 ½ x 6 ½ inches of light strips.

Cutting Instructions for Border:

Cut 2 each 8 ½ inches x 40 inches (width of fabric) of border fabric.
Place on 2 ½ inch strip die and cut into 6 each 2 ½ x 40" strips. These will be stitched together for the border.

Cutting Instructions for the Border using the Rotary Cutter:

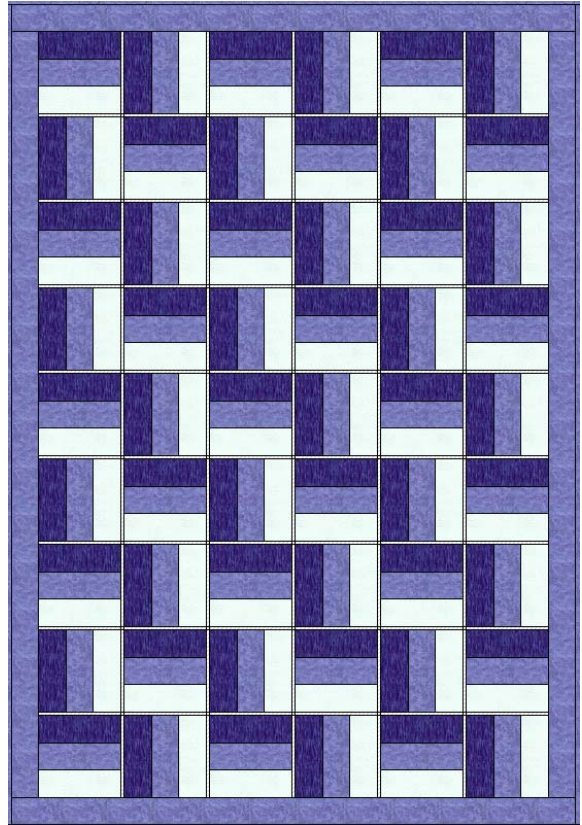
Cut 6 strips that are 2 ½ x 40 inches (width of fabric).

Block Construction:

Stitch the dark 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch rectangle to the medium 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch rectangle.
Next stitch the light 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch rectangle to the medium 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch rectangle to complete the block.
Make 54 blocks.



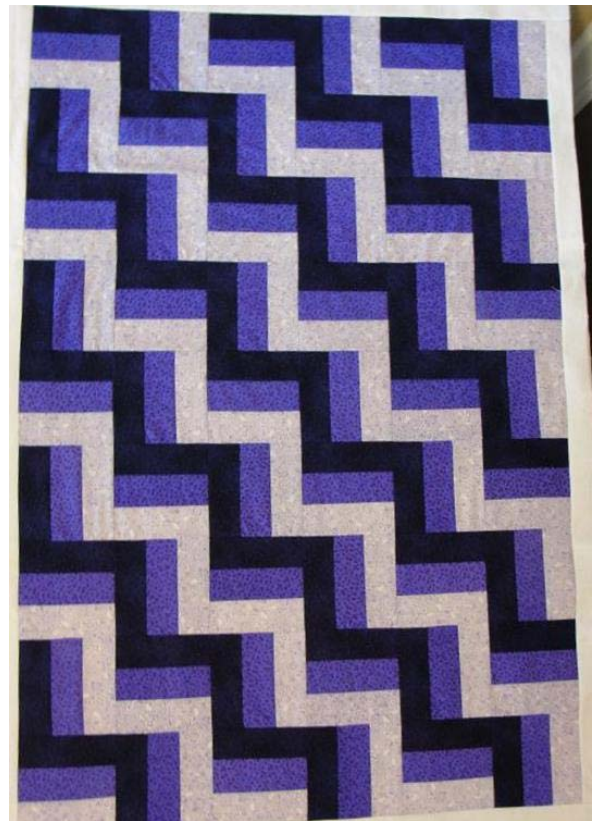
Sew rows together as shown.



Cut side border strips to fit the length of the quilt top. Lay the quilt out flat on a table or the floor and measure from the top center edge of the quilt to the bottom center edge of the quilt. Cut the border to that measurement and sew to sides of quilt.

The top and bottom border strips are cut after the side strips are stitched to the quilt top. Cut the top and bottom border strips as follows: Lay the quilt out flat on a table or on the floor and measure from the left side center edge of the quilt to the right side center edge of the quilt. Sew the borders to top and bottom edges of the quilt.

Finished size is approximately 40 x 58 inches.



Layer with batting, quilt or tie, and bind.
