



Easy and Elegant Table Runner (cutting instructions for Accuquilt GO die cutting system)
Finished Size 16 x 62 inches
Cutting instructions are written in order of cutting to maximize fabric utilization.

Yardage needed:

Feature fabric: 1/4 yards

Background fabric: 1/2 yards

Sashing fabric: 3/8 yards,

Border, and Binding fabric: 1.25 yards

Accuquilt GO dies used:

6.5" square

6.5" triangles

1.5", 2.5" strip dies

Cutting instructions:

Center Blocks (Feature fabric):

Cut 5 blocks 6.5" x 6.5" using the GO 6.5" square die

Setting Triangles (Background fabric):

Cut 2 blocks 12.5" x 12.5." (rotary cut)

Cut into quarter square triangles by cutting diagonally from corner to corner.

Corner Triangles (Background fabric):

Cut 4 triangles using the Accuquilt GO 6.5" half square triangle die.

Borders and Binding (Border/Binding fabric):

Cut 40" across WOF

Use the GO 2.5" strip die to cut 9 each 2.5" x 40" strips (for border and binding)

Sashing strips for blocks (Sashing fabric):

Cut 8.5" x WOF. Cut this into two 21 inch pieces. Cut one of the pieces 6.5" x 21".

Layer these pieces on the GO 1.5" strip die and cut

10 each 1.5 x 6.5" strips

10 each 1.5 x 8.5" strips

Now for variation, try this with some of those orphan quilt blocks you have sitting around. How about some stars or pinwheels as Center Blocks?
