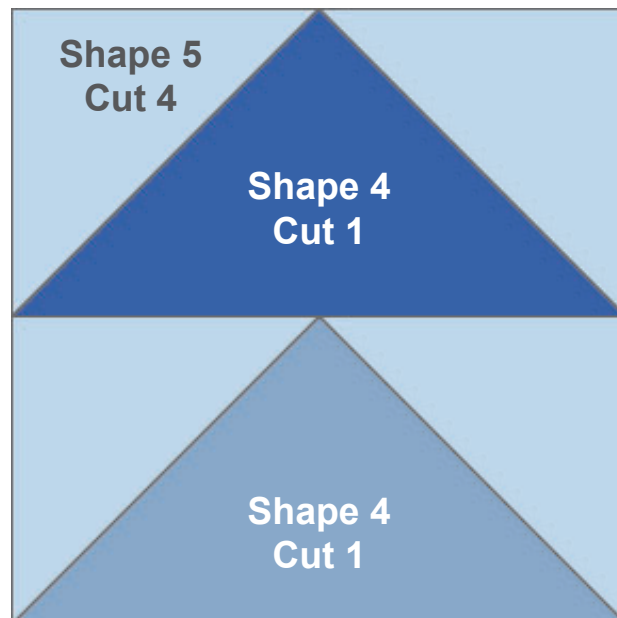
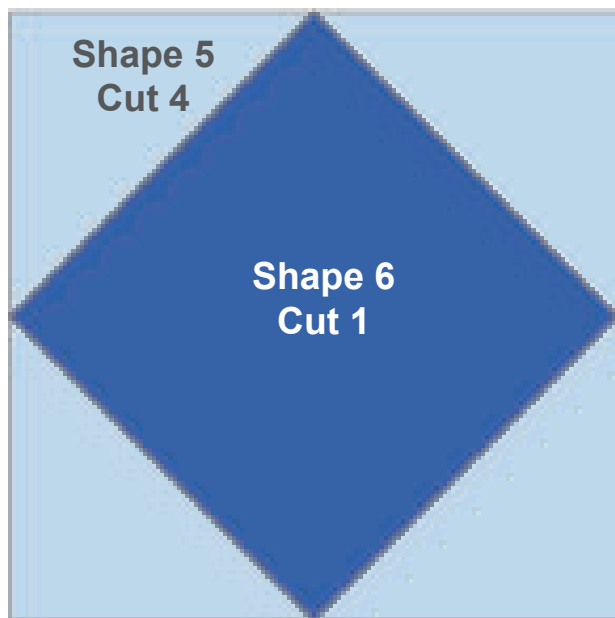


# Block 10

## Flying Geese and Square on Point Border

### Make 12 Blocks



### Cutting Instructions:

Shape 4 = Quarter Square Triangle (QST)

Shape 5 = Half Square Triangle (HST)

Shape 6 = Square on Point (SOP)

## Block 10 Flying Geese and Square on Point Border Instructions

Instructions are for 1 block. Make 6 Flying Geese Blocks and make 6 Square on Point Blocks.

1. Sew a light Shape 5 HST and a medium Shape 4 QST together as shown. Press seams open. Sew a light Shape 5 HST to the opposite side of the medium Shape 4 QST to make a complete Flying Geese unit. Press seam open. Make 6 medium Flying Geese units.



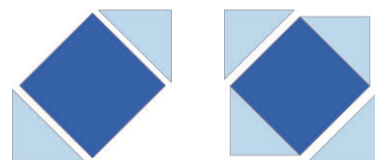
Sew a light Shape 5 HST and a dark Shape 4 QST together as shown. Press seams open. Sew a light Shape 5 HST to the opposite side of the dark Shape 4 QST to make a complete Flying Geese unit. Press seams open. Make 6 dark Flying Geese units.



Sew the two Flying Geese units together as shown. Press seams open or to one side. Make 6 complete double Flying Geese units.



2. Sew a light Shape 5 HST to opposite sides of the dark Shape 6 SOP. Press seams open. Sew a light Shape 5 HST to the remaining opposite sides of the dark Shape 6 SOP. Press seams open. Make 6 SOP unit.



**Border Construction:** Arrange the Flying Geese and Squares on Point alternating the units as shown starting with the SOP and ending with the SOP in the row. Turn the Flying Geese points toward or away from the SOP units as shown in the diagram. Stitch Flying Geese and SOP units together to make one row. Press seams open or to one side.



NOTE: The number of Flying Geese and Square on Point units is a suggestion. Please feel free to use your own configuration of Geese and SOP units to make a border that pleases you.
