

Corrections for pages 3 and 7 in the Gingerbread Cookie Quilt.

As hard as I try, sometimes an error gets past. The corrections are on pages 3 and 7 and corrects the cutting instructions for the square on point for the Gingerbread House embroidery. The filename has changed to reflect the date of the update. The correction can be found below and the pattern itself has been corrected.

Square on Point Gingerbread House Blocks: The houses are stitched on gray fabric. The fabric is cut as a 7" square and placed on point in the machine embroidery hoop. It is best to use a sticky stabilizer or temporary spray adhesive to hold the fabric in place on the stabilizer during stitching. When the stitching is completed, remove the embroidery from the hoop and tear or cut away excess stabilizer from the back of the embroidery. Press by placing embroidery face down on a towel or wool mat and carefully press from the back. Some stabilizers will shrink so test your stabilizer for shrinkage before pressing. Do not press stabilized area if you have a stabilizer that shrinks.

After removing stabilizer and pressing, use a rotary cutter to cut the square on point (SOP). Center the house and cut the SOP exactly 4-3/4" square. The SOP quilt block is finished using the Shape 3 HST from the GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block as shown below.
