

This quilt is designed to be used with the AccuQuilt GO! Gingerbread Cookie, Gingerbread Decorations and Reiko Kato House Applique Embroidery Designs by Marjorie Busby and the AccuQuilt GO! QUBE Mix & Match 4" Block and 6" Block die sets. Any combination of embroidery designs from the gingerbread cookie and gingerbread house design sets can be used in this quilt.

Fabric Yardage

- ▶ 2-7/8 yards red fabric for connector blocks, borders, and binding.
- ▶ 2-1/2 yards background for blocks, machine embroidery blocks, and borders.
- ▶ 1/2 yard gray fabric for ginger house embroidery blocks.
- ▶ Quilt Backing 56" x 68" (Additional fabric may be needed to account for shrinkage if backing is laundered before quilting).
- ▶ Quilt Batting 56" x 68"
- ▶ Iron-on Fusible for Applique Shapes
- ▶ Assorted fabrics in desired colors for applique.

- ▶ The Gingerbread Cookie and Gingerbread House Embroidery Designs instructions list all supplies required to complete the embroidery.



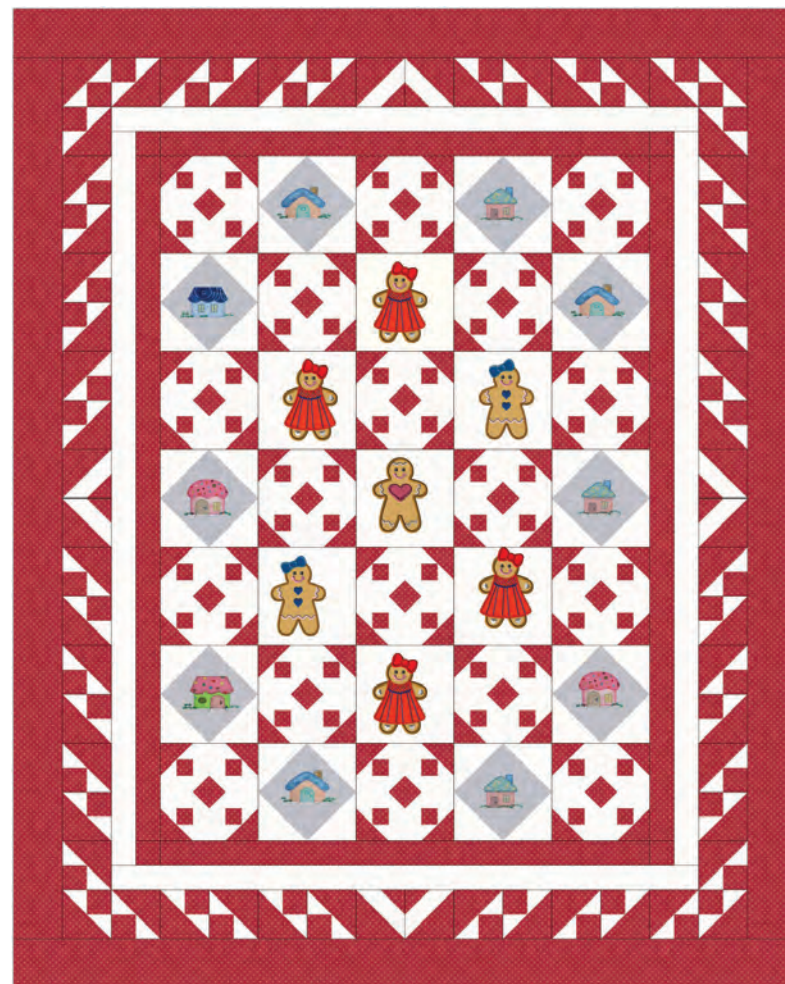

Ginger Cookie House Embroidery Block (6" Finished) Make 10 blocks

Rotary Cut	Fabric	# to cut	Precut Size	Cutting Instructions
Square on Point for 6" finished Block (4-1/4" square Finished)	gray	10	Cut 7" square for embroidery. Place on point in the embroidery hoop and complete embroidery.	This cannot be cut using the die because embroidery must be centered on the block. Carefully center the completed embroidery and cut a 4-3/4" square on point around the embroidered ginger cookie house. When seamed, this will finish at 4-1/4" square although the square is set on point and will fit a 6" block.

Ginger Cookie People Embroidery Block (6" Finished) Make 7 blocks

Rotary Cut	Fabric	# to cut	Precut Size	Cutting Instructions
6-1/2" Square (6" Finished)	background	7	Cut 8-9" square for embroidery. Place in the embroidery hoop and complete embroidery.	This cannot be cut using a die because embroidery must be centered on the block. Carefully center the completed embroidery and cut a 6-1/2" square around each embroidered ginger cookie person.

GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55014)	Binding	Cut 2—8-1/2" x WOF. Place on 2-1/2" strip die and cut 6—2-1/2" x WOF strips. Join with 45 degree angle seams to make 240" of quilt binding.

Cutting Instructions for Applique Shapes are included in the Machine Embroidery Design Instructions.

Machine embroidery quilt blocks are constructed after the machine embroidery is completed. Complete instructions for the machine embroidery are included in a separate set of instructions. Machine embroidery blocks are pressed and cut to size as per instructions. Instructions for completing the pieced quilt blocks are also included below.

This quilt has the following blocks:

- Red and white connector blocks
- Plain blocks for Gingerbread Cookie people
- Square on Point blocks for Gingerbread Cookie houses
- Two different border blocks

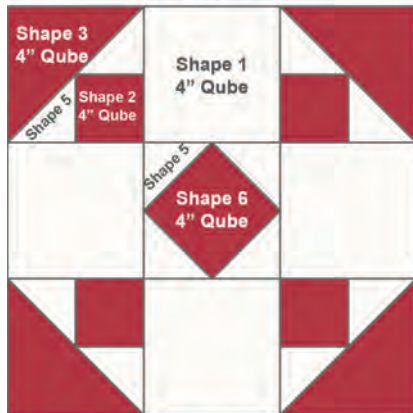

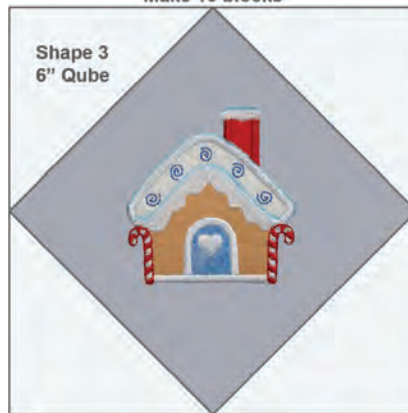
GO! Gingerbread Cookie Machine Embroidery Block - Finished 6" Block
 Make 7 different blocks



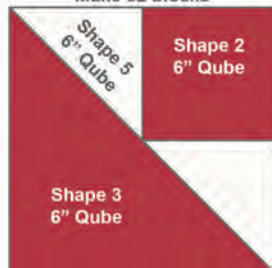
GO! QUBE Mix & Match 4" Block Dies

 Make 18 blocks



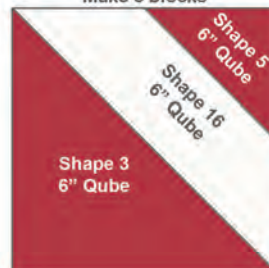

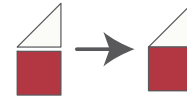
Block Construction: Connector Blocks

The center of the quilt is made up of connector blocks and machine embroidery blocks. The connector blocks are made using the GO! QUBE Mix & Match 4" Block. Seam allowances are 1/4" and it is recommended that seams be pressed open.

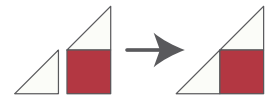
Make 18 blocks.

HST with a Square in the Corner Subunit: Make 4 Subunits for each block (18 blocks = 72 subunits).

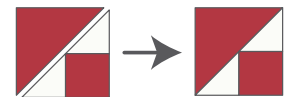
Stitch the short side of a Shape 5 HST to a Shape 2 square as shown. Press seam open.



Stitch a second Shape 5 HST to the other side of the Shape 2 square to form a HST with a square in the corner. Press seam open.

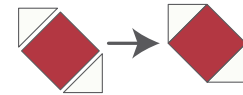


Arrange the HST with a square in the corner with a Shape 3 HST and stitch together to make a HST Square in the Corner Subunit.

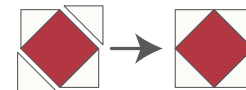


Square on Point (SOP) Subunit: Make 1 Subunit for each block (18 blocks = 18 subunits).

Stitch a Shape 5 HST to either side of a Shape 6 SOP. Press seams open.



Stitch a Shape 5 HST to the remaining two sides of the Shape 6 SOP as shown. Make 1 SOP subunit.



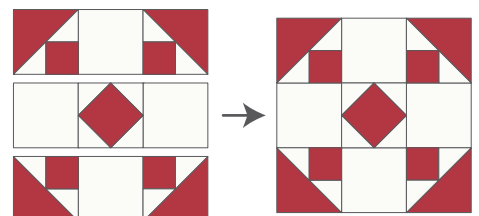
Top and Bottom Rows of Block: Arrange two HST with a Square Subunits and a Shape 2 Square as shown. Stitch the subunits together. Press seams open. Make two rows—a top row and a bottom row.



Center Row of Block: Arrange two Shape 2 Squares and a SOP subunit to make the center row of the block. Stitch the subunits together. Press seams open. Make one center row.



Assemble Block: Arrange top, bottom, and center rows as shown. Stitch together, matching subunit seams. Press seams open or to one side.



Ginger Cookie Quilt

Block Construction: Embroidery Blocks

Gingerbread Cookie Blocks: Cut an 8" square and complete embroidery (see embroidery design set for full instructions). Remove completed embroidery from the hoop and trim or tear away stabilizer from the back of the embroidery. Press by placing embroidery face down on a towel or wool mat and carefully press from the back. Some stabilizers will shrink so test your stabilizer for shrinkage before pressing. Do not press stabilized area if you have a stabilizer that shrinks.

After removing stabilizer and pressing, using a 6-1/2" square ruler, center the embroidery and carefully trim with a rotary cutter. Your Gingerbread Cookie embroidery block is now ready to be used in the quilt.



Square on Point Gingerbread House Blocks: The houses are stitched on gray fabric. The fabric is cut as a 7" square and placed on point in the machine embroidery hoop. It is best to use a sticky stabilizer or temporary spray adhesive to hold the fabric in place on the stabilizer during stitching. When the stitching is completed, remove the embroidery from the hoop and tear or cut away excess stabilizer from the back of the embroidery. Press by placing embroidery face down on a towel or wool mat and carefully press from the back. Some stabilizers will shrink so test your stabilizer for shrinkage before pressing. Do not press stabilized area if you have a stabilizer that shrinks.

After removing stabilizer and pressing, use a rotary cutter to cut the square on point (SOP). Center the house and cut the SOP exactly 4-3/4" square. The SOP quilt block is finished using the Shape 3 HST from the GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block as shown below.

Stitch a Shape 3 HST to either side of the finished embroidery SOP as shown. Press seams open or to one side.



Stitch a Shape 3 HST to the remaining two sides of the finished embroidery SOP as shown. Make 10 SOP Gingerbread House Blocks.

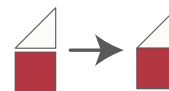
Block Construction: Border Block #1 and Border Block #2

The quilt has two solid borders and a border of pieced blocks. The pieced blocks are made with the GO! QUBE Mix & Match 6" Block and the GO! QUBE Angles Companion 6" Block. Seam allowances are 1/4" and it is recommended that seams be pressed open.

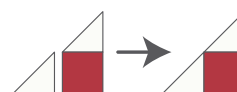
Make 24 Border Block #1. Make 8 Border Block #2.

Border Block #1—HST with a Square in the Corner Border Block: Make 52 blocks.

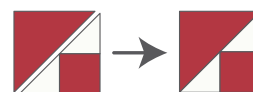
Stitch the short side of a Shape 5 HST to a Shape 2 square as shown. Press seam open.



Stitch a second Shape 5 HST to the other side of the Shape 2 square to form a HST with a square in the corner. Press seam open.

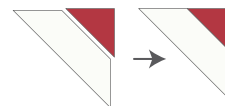


Arrange the HST with a square in the corner with a Shape 3 HST and stitch together to make a HST Square in the Corner Border Block.

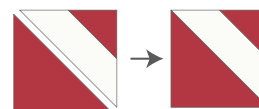


Border Block #2—Trapezoid Border Blocks: Make 8 blocks.

Stitch a light Shape 5 HST and a Shape 16 Trapezoid together as shown. Press seams open.



Stitch a light Shape 3 HST and the trapezoid HST together as shown. Press seams open.



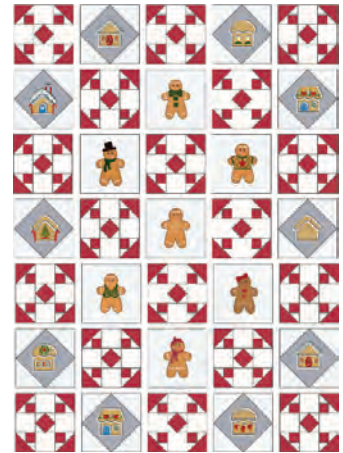
Construction of Pieced Blocks Border:

Arrange Border blocks as shown. There will be ten blocks in the horizontal top and bottom borders and 14 blocks in the vertical right and left side borders. Stitch blocks together matching inner seams. Press seams open.



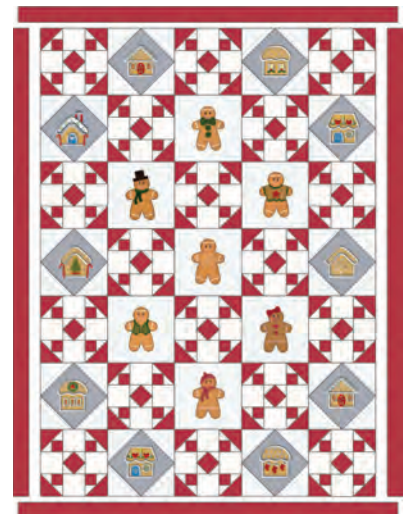
Ginger Cookie Quilt Quilt Assembly

Assembly of Quilt Blocks: Arrange completed pieced quilt blocks and machine embroidery blocks as shown in this diagram. Stitch blocks together into rows and stitch rows together to complete the quilt block section of the quilt. Press seams open or to one side.



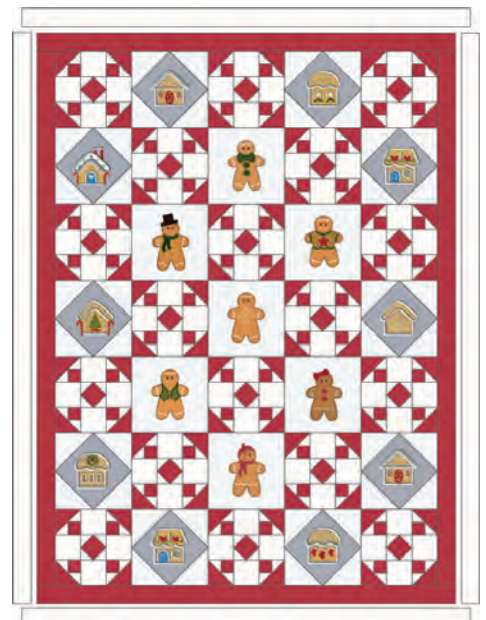
Red Inner Border: Stitch red vertical inner side border to the quilt block section. Press seams toward the vertical border.

Stitch red horizontal inner top and bottom border to the quilt block section. Press seams toward the red horizontal borders.



White Inner Border: Stitch light background vertical inner side borders to the red inner vertical borders. Press seams toward the inner red vertical borders.

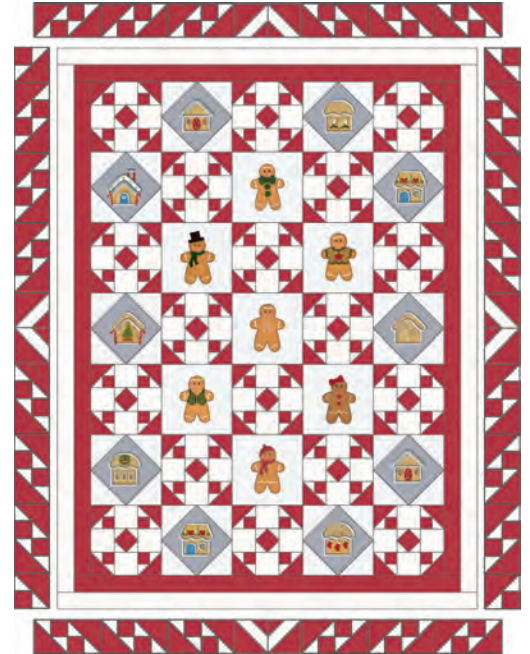
Stitch the light background horizontal inner top and bottom border to the inner red borders as shown. Press seams toward the red inner horizontal borders.



Ginger Cookie Quilt Quilt Construction

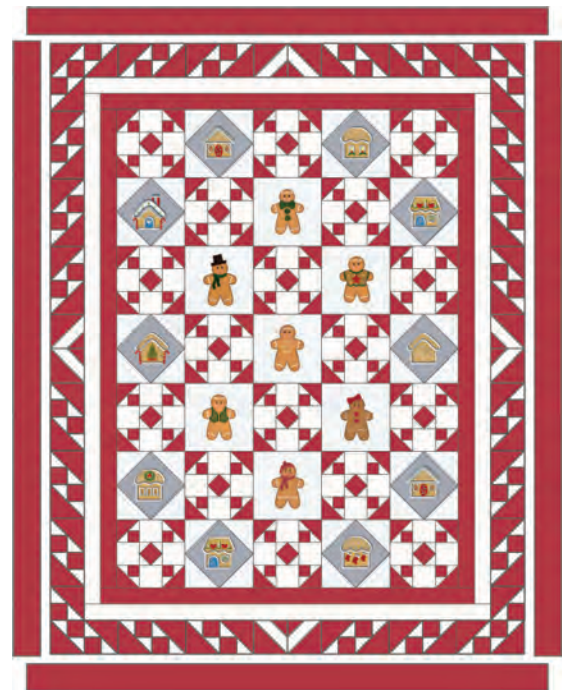
Pieced Block Border: Stitch the vertical pieced blocks side borders to the completed inner quilt blocks and borders. Press seams toward the inner light background border.

Stitch the horizontal pieced blocks top and bottom borders to the completed inner quilt blocks and borders as shown. Press seams toward the inner light background borders.



Outer Red Border: Stitch the red vertical outer side borders to the pieced block borders. Press seams toward the red outer side borders.

Stitch the red horizontal outer top and bottom border to the pieced block borders as shown. Press seams toward the red outer top and bottom borders.



Finishing:

Layer quilt with batting and backing.

Quilt as desired.

Finish your quilt with the coordinating binding.

Enjoy your accomplishment.
